

# The Walker Family Band Music Workshop

## Code of Conduct Agreement

These rules are intended to assist in providing for the health, safety, and social well being of our High School Group participants at The Walker Family Band Music Workshop, and others sharing the BRCC facilities at this time. Guidelines listed below are reasonable, standard protocols and plain common sense. If you experience a situation, or a question arises, where additional guidance would be helpful, please bring it to the attention of a staff member.

- A full class schedule and attendance at all instructional sessions and scheduled group activities is required. Please be prompt.
- Participants should be back at the group lodge each night by 11:00 pm. Sleeping is strongly encouraged at this time; maintaining respectful quiet is mandatory. **Lights out is at midnight.** (Saturday night exception for lights out is camp tradition.)
- Many areas are available for mixed gender socialization at the facility hosting our workshop. Co-ed socialization at Calvin Lodge is restricted to the kitchen/activity room on the lower level, the upper level living room, and the upper and lower decks. **Sleeping quarters are off limits for social gathering. Participants are not to enter any bedroom unless you are assigned to that specific room. Please respect the privacy of others.** It is also appreciated if participants monitor their volume after their house mates call it a night.
- BRCC is a smoke free facility. At no time will there be smoking of anything, anywhere.
- Possession and/or use of any illegal substance is, of course, forbidden. Prescription drugs must be recorded prior to the start of the workshop and secured by the participant or stored in a lock box. (Please see the Health and Medical Information Form.)
- Obviously, all types of weapons are prohibited. Please do not bring fireworks to camp.
- If it is necessary for a high school participant to drive to the workshop, his/her vehicle must remain parked until that participant's departure. Keys will be collected at registration and returned upon check out. Unless you

are with a workshop staff member, you are not permitted to leave the facility for any purpose. **If a personal emergency should arise, a parent/guardian must speak to a faculty member in charge to confirm their permission before an exception is made.**

- Please respect the workshop facilities and natural surroundings. Do not deface or destroy them in any way. Deposit all litter in the containers provided and recycle when receptacles are available. Please leave the premises in as good, or **better**, condition than it was upon your arrival.
- It is not possible to anticipate every situation that might come up. Please be mindful of your personal safety and the safety of others, taking note especially of pool rules. **LET COMMON SENSE AND COURTESY BE THE GUIDELINE FOR ALL YOUR DECISIONS.**

**The nature of the WFB Music Workshop is to be a place of creative collaboration and spiritual sensitivity. It is intended to be an experience of learning and sharing. One of the main goals of our camp is for all students, adults, and faculty to be completely interactive. Younger students will naturally be influenced by the high school students. It is essential to the spirit and mission of The Walker Family Band Camp that high school students remain aware that they come to camp as teachers as well as students.**

**Violation of any of the rules listed above is grounds for dismissal and forfeiture of workshop fees. Parents will be promptly notified. Any individual so dismissed must call a parent or guardian and arrange transportation home.**

**Statement:** I have read and understand the Code of Conduct Agreement and agree to abide by the rules and regulations listed herein, and to abide by any further reasonable requests made for group safety and security by staff and facility personnel. I agree to maintain an attitude of acceptance and inclusion of other members of the high school group, treating each with kindness and respect. I agree to extend friendship and collaborate with the group in ways that enrich my experience and the experiences of the other members of the group. I understand fully that failure to adhere to the guidelines within this agreement could result in immediate dismissal from camp.
