

GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE WORKSHOP / FACILITY

REGISTRATION and TUITION COSTS:

- Tuition is discounted to \$99.00 for participants who register on or before October 15th.
- Discounts are available to families with multiple participants enrolling in the workshop.
- Registrations received on or after October will be billed \$124.00 for the first applicant. Additional family members will get the standard 20% discount.
- Participants are welcome to enroll Saturday, Nov. 4th, for Saturday classes and workshop activities, however, the deadline for guaranteed on site lodging is October 27th.
- We are happy to add participants to a small group class on Friday afternoon if space is available.
- Small groups are priced at \$60.00 per hour. Individual cost per person is determined according to the number of students per class. (Limit: 4 per class) The cost for small group classes is NOT INCLUDED in the tuition fee for the workshop.
- Once you submit an online registration form, it will be emailed to The Walker Family Band. An invoice will be created and emailed to you detailing your costs. Payment is expected upon receipt of your invoice.

HOUSING OPTIONS:

A separate pdf document detailing lodging options is uploaded on the 2017 Haw River Workshop page on our website.

Lodging costs will be included on your workshop invoice and must be paid to The Walker Family Band. Lodging requests received after Oct 27th ARE NOT GUARANTEED. Haw River State Park charges and additional \$5.00 per person per night for ALL lodging requests made after October 27th.

Guests can check into their rooms at 3:00pm and must check out / return keys NO LATER than 10:00am to avoid additional fees.

MEALS AND SPECIAL DIETARY REQUESTS:

- The Summit facility includes 3 meals with each overnight guest reservation. All meals (Friday dinner through Sunday lunch) are included for guests staying Friday and Saturday nights.
- Either Friday OR Saturday dinner and Saturday breakfast and lunch is provided to guests staying Friday night only.
- Saturday Lunch, dinner and Sunday breakfast will be provided for guests staying Saturday night only. (Let us know if you need an adjustment.)
- Additional meals for guests and commuter meals are \$9.50 per person, per meal.
- Meals are served as follows:
 - Breakfast: 8:00 - 8:45
 - Lunch: 12:00 - 12:45
 - Dinner: 6:00 - 6:45
- The cafeteria staff at the Summit Conference Center will make every effort to accommodate participants having food allergies or dietary modifications. However, participants **MUST** submit specific dietary requests on or before October 27th to allow time for the staff to plan appropriately.
- There is a \$2.00 up charge for all gluten free meals.
- Participants should be advised that there are no refrigerators available for personal use. Please bring a cooler if you have food, beverages, or medications requiring refrigeration. The cafeteria refrigerator cannot be used for this purpose but the staff is happy to provide ice for your cooler.

The Walker Family Band has purchased a permit that allows participants (21 and over) to have beer and/or wine on the premises. No other type of alcohol is permitted. Alcohol is permitted in individual rooms and in conference rooms reserved for workshop classes and gatherings. We are NOT permitted to bring alcoholic beverages into the cafeteria.

MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION:

- Wi-Fi:
- Please be aware: cell phone service may be sketchy at Summit Conference Center.
- There is a land line (red phone in the lobby) that is available to guests at all times.
- In case of a medical or a law enforcement emergency you can call 911 from the red phone if your cell phone has weak reception.
- A park Ranger is on duty 24 hours. The contact number will be posted by the red phone in the lobby and we are asked to contact the Ranger in addition to 911 in cases of law enforcement or medical emergencies.

- Summit Conference Center staff person is on site from 7:00 AM until 9:00 PM.
- The gate to the park is open at night, so you can leave if the need arrives.
- PLEASE DO NOT contact conference center staff or the park Ranger between 9:00 PM and 7:00 AM for reasons other than medical or law enforcement emergencies.
- Facility problems should be reported to staff during their scheduled working hours.
- Please contact Scott Walker (336-314-2266) or Teresja Poole - (336-420-2488) to report non-emergency facility issues (plumbing, lights, etc.) if conference center staff have gone for the day.
- Only official service dogs are allowed in any of the conference center facilities. Please leave all pets at home.

HAW RIVER STATE PARK PUBLIC ACTIVITIES:

Activities and equipment will be available for use by guests of the Summit Environmental Education and Conference Center during our workshop weekend. A key is available to us to open storage facilities housing the canoes, paddles and life vests. Copies of regulations pertinent to boating and activities on the lake are available to guests per request. In addition to boating, fishing, and hiking trails, a disk golf course and a gymnasium are also located at the facility and available to our group. Neither The Walker Family Band or Park Services is responsible for providing lifeguards or other supervisory personnel. If you choose to take part in any of the many activities available for public use at The Summit Environmental Educational and Conference Center or on Haw River State Park it is understood that you do so at your own risk.
